The Goochland Community Action Program (GCAP) is administered through the Goochland Department of Social Services. The program focuses on reducing poverty and promoting self-sufficiency for Goochland County residents. To do this, GCAP provides financial support to low-income residents seeking affordable job training programs, education, housing, summer camp, food, and utilities. We also partner with community

organizations who provide programs and services to those experiencing economic hardships.
