WHAT IS THE GOOCHLAND COMMUNITY ACTION PROGRAM?

GCAP is administered through the Goochland Department of Social Services. The program is federally funded and focuses on reducing poverty and promoting self-sufficiency for Goochland County residents. To do this, GCAP provides financial support to low-income residents seeking affordable job training programs, education, housing, summer camp, child care, food, and utilities. **GCAP's ability to provide assistance is based on available funding.**

GCAP CAN ASSIST INCOME- ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS WITH:

- Electric and utility bills, up to \$600
- Rent or mortgage assistance*
- Monthly food gift cards for Walmart
- Job training, education, or a certification course
- After-school care and summer camp

*Assistance is available **up to** the HUD Fair Market Rent Value for the home, which is based on the number of bedrooms in the home.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE?

Must meet both criteria:

1. Goochland County resident
2. Income 200% or less of federal poverty level
